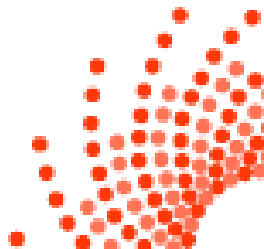
Fellowship Goals

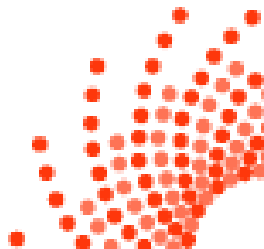


Fellowship Overview: WEEK ONE

We will curate an exhibit together

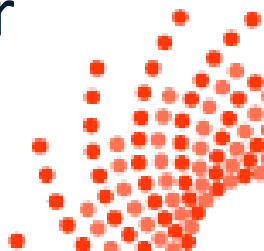
- Select items

Goal: Determine and begin research projects

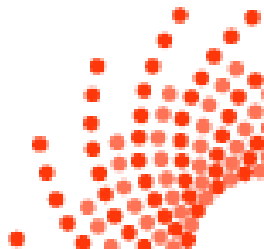
- Based on one of your topics of interest
